

Fire, Water, Road and Railway Safety

- **Never** play with matches, lighters or any other things that can set on fire. If you see a fire please call the Fire brigade on 999
- Swim in safe areas and don't go out of your depth
- Always find the safest place to cross a road, look in all directions for traffic. When there is no traffic, cross the road
- **Never** play on railway tracks. **Never** climb over or through a fence near a railway track. **Never** climb

How to stay safe

In college

- Speak to your Form Tutor/HOY or SLT Link if something is worrying you
- Speak to a member of staff on duty at break, lunchtime or after college if something is worrying you during these times
- If you see a visitor in college who hasn't got a visitors badge and is not wearing a grey lanyard you **must** speak to a member of staff straight away

In the community

- Speak to an adult (Parent, Guardian, or other relative) if you have seen something or somebody doing something wrong in the community
- Speak to or ring the Police if you are in any danger in the community
