Uniform Expectations and Consequences - We are preparing our students for life beyond the college, therefore we expect all our students to attend wearing full school uniform, with a business-like appearance. It is the parents/carers/students responsibility to ensure that this happens.

<u>Item</u>	<u>Uniform Expectations</u>	<u>Consequence if Expectations are not met</u>
Skirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black • Loose fitting all over • Plain in design • Knee length 	Student will spend time in reflection with a member of staff until they meet the uniform expectations
Tights/Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plain Black • Socks must be plain black or white and ankle length. No socks in any colour at knee length or above the knee. Socks must not be worn along with tights 	Student will spend time in reflection with a member of staff until they meet the uniform expectations
Trousers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black • Loose fitting all over • Plain in design 	Student will spend time in reflection with a member of staff until they meet the uniform expectations
Tie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • College clip-on tie 	Student will spend time in reflection with a member of staff until they meet the uniform expectations
Jumper/ Cardigan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black • V neck • Plain in design • Long sleeves 	Student will spend time in reflection with a member of staff until they meet the uniform expectations
Shirt/Blouse	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • White Cotton • Collar • Buttoned to the neck 	Student will spend time in reflection with a member of staff until they meet the uniform expectations
Blazer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • College Blazer 	Student will spend time in reflection with a member of staff until they meet the uniform expectations
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black • Leather look • Business Like (See example photographs)	Student will spend time in reflection with a member of staff until they meet the uniform expectations
Jewellery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One small stud in each ear lobe • One wrist watch • One ring • No facial or body piercings 	Inappropriate jewellery will be confiscated and stored in student engagement office until collected at 3.30pm on Friday only.
Make-up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No make-up in KS3 • Unnoticeable make-up in KS4 • No false nails (including acrylic, shellac or gel nails) • No nail varnish • No false eyelashes 	Students will be supervised while they remove it/them. Should students refuse or are unable to remove items the college deem unacceptable then the student will be placed in reflection.
Accessories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If head scarves are to be worn for medical reasons or religious purposes they must be plain black or purple. • Headbands/Hair slides must be black or purple • Fashion accessories such as neck scarves are not permitted • Belts should be plain black with no big buckles on them 	Students will be supervised while they remove it/them. Items will be confiscated and stored in the Student Engagement office until collected at 3.30pm on Friday only. Should students refuse to remove items the college deem unacceptable then the student will be placed in reflection.
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appropriate business-like style and natural colour - no vibrant hair colours, tramlines or patterns in hair are not allowed 	Student will spend time in reflection with a member of staff until they meet the uniform expectations
Coats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dark coloured coat 	NOTE: Coats will be confiscated if they are worn inside the building.

Skirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Black• Loose fitting all over• Plain in design• Knee length
Tights	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plain Black
Trousers / Leggings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Black of style
T – Shirt / hoodie	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• P16 T-Shirt with logo• P16 hoodie with logo
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Black of any style
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Appropriate business-like style and natural colour

PLEASE NOTE: Students in incorrect dress, which fails to meet the post 16 dress expectations will be sent home to change. Post 16 dress issues must be resolved in a timely manner or formal warning procedures will be initiated.
